



Chem 31A Fall 2013: Register your i>Clicker Remote in Coursework

1. Log into Coursework (<https://coursework.stanford.edu/>) with your SUNet ID and password.
2. Enter the Chem31A course website by clicking the F13-CHEM-31A tab.
3. Click the “i>clicker” tab on the left panel of the worksite.
