

CS193C Sample Final Quiz Questions

The final quiz will primarily test you on theory, terminology, and topics not covered on the midterm (e.g., AJAX and Flash). The quiz is only worth 10% of your final grade.

The final quiz will be ~15 questions, with the bulk short answer, although we could throw in some true/false, multiple choice, or matching questions in.

Here are some sample questions to get an idea of the general format. If you're worried about the exam and want an idea of what else might be on it, I recommend going through your lecture notes for each class and asking yourself (or your study group) what sort of questions I might ask from that class.

1. Describe two differences in syntax between XHTML and HTML.
2. The JavaScript `Navigator` object type can be used to determine which web browser a user is running. This method for determining a web browser's capabilities is no longer recommended. Describe a better method for determining browser capabilities.
3. What does "Cascading" mean in the context of Cascading Style Sheets? Describe (very briefly) an example of cascading.
4. What is the relationship between a tag and an element?
