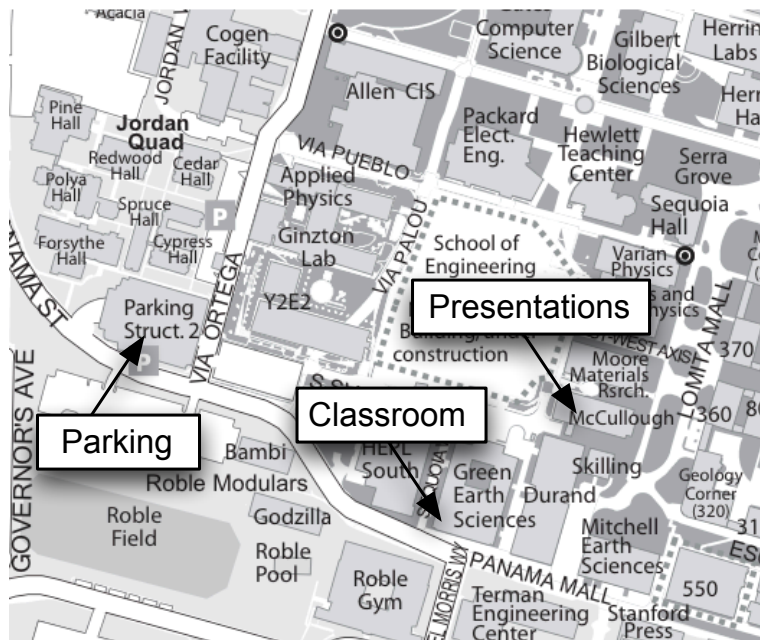
Final Projects The final projects are due Monday Dec 7th at the scheduled final exam time. You can present your final projects either as a 10-15 page report, or as a 10 minute oral presentation. Please send me the following information by Friday

- Title of your presentation
- Whether you want an oral or written presentation

I will work out a program, and email it to you on Sunday. The location of presentations will be

- Room McCullough 122

Presentation Guidelines

Oral Presentations You can use any presentation package you like (Powerpoint, Keynote, PDF). You can send me the presentation ahead of time, and use my computer, or use your own computer. Either way, please give me your presentation by day of the presentation.

- You will have 10 minutes for your presentation. You will get a warning at 8 minutes, and will need to conclude at 10 minutes. There will be two minutes for questions.
- You will need 10-15 slides, and certainly no more. This should be structured as

- Title (1 slide)
 - Project description (1-2 slides)
 - Background (2-3 slides)
 - Your results (4-5 slides)
 - Conclusions (1 slide)
- Avoid detailed mathematics or derivations, you won't have time to go through them. Focus on the concepts, using illustrations, graphs, and examples.
 - Practice talking through your presentation, to make sure that you can really do it in 10 minutes.

Written Presentations Written presentations should be 10-15 pages long, following the same general structure as the oral presentations. Send these to me as a pdf file by the time of the final presentations.
