Technology and Training Make the Difference

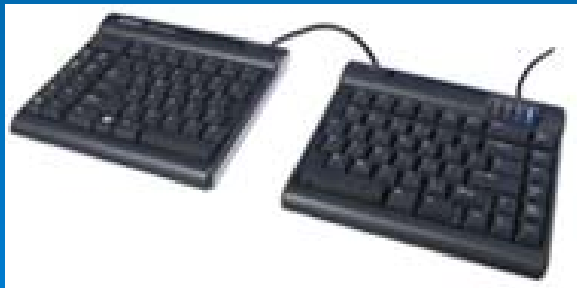

- Funded by foundation grants, the Department of Rehabilitation and private pay/fee for service.



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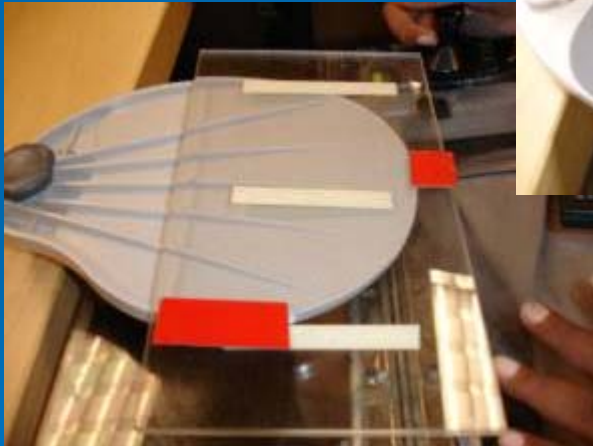

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Mouse Tray Extension



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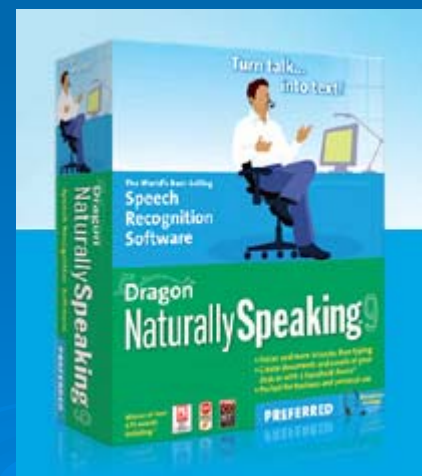
