# PROJECT DESCRIPTION

We made RAFT more accessible to special education teachers through redesigning the website and through creating an activity kit for students with disabilities



# RAFT BACKGROUND

- Resource Area for Teaching
- Hands-on learning
- Provides idea sheets, classroom kits, supplies, and resource staff
- Extremely affordable for teachers
- Currently does not address special needs students





## **The Problem:** RAFT is not currently organized as a strong resource for special education teachers.

Children in California with a Learning Disability: 149,000


US Children with a Learning Disability: 1.7 million


US Children with Disabilities: 6.6 million

affordable, targeted educational systems for children with disabilities.










## **Clocks Rock!**

- not as dynamic for repetition






### **Math Blast**

Three Activities

(1) Battleship Math: a 2-person interactive game where kids need to guess the operation. Mastermind with math!

2.) Higher, Lower: Helps kids develop an intuition about number quantities, addition, and subtraction.

3.) Placeholders: Students learn the concept of 10's, 100's, and 1000's





### **BENEFITS AND ADVANTAGES**


- Kit is simple, low prep, and low cleanup
- Multiple activities
- Encourages peer to peer interaction, but can also be solo
- Repetition and ownership of space
- Flexibility to frame to match IEPs
- Can adapt with advancing curriculum, meets state standards (Everyday Math)
- Adaptable to for mainstream classroom use

## **USER TESTING FEEDBACK**

- Versatility of math concepts
- Personal space for students
- Highly repetitive
- Promotes teamwork

## **FUTURE STEPS**

- Simple pictorial instructions
- Integration into specific curriculum (eg Everyday Math)
- Website development

### **RAFT can be a great resource for special education teachers or homeschooled students!**

Activity Kits are hands-on learning projects that come with RAFT materials pre-packaged; Idea Sheets are RAFT designed projects like the Activity Kits, but you can just download the instructions and use your own materials.

The Activity Kits and Idea Sheets featured here are selected from our database under the following criteria

- \* easy facilitation; no significant prep time or cleanup
- \* enhanced safety; no safety pins, or hot glue
- \* adaptable; every child is different, and these activities can be individually tailored to their learning goals
- \* sort and search through the activities/idea sheets either by grade level, or by specific learning disability

Under "Troubleshooting" are resources to help adapt activities for special day classes, such as alternatives to hot glue. You can also submit your own advice as a resource for other teachers, and view upcoming special ed workshops.
