





- Abortion rates for Down Syndrome pregnancies:
 - About 92% of pregnancies in Europe with a diagnosis of Down syndrome are terminated. In the United States, termination rates are around 67%, but this rate varies significantly depending upon the population evaluated.
 - When non-pregnant people (men & women) are asked if they would have a termination if their fetus tested positive, 23 33% said yes, when high-risk pregnant women were asked, 46 86% said yes, and when women who screened positive are asked, 89 97% say yes.




