

METHODOLOGY

DATA: 2015 quarterback stats from Pro-Football-Reference.com

METHOD: Regression to the mean of true talent


$$\sigma_T^2 = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^n \frac{(S_i - \mu_T)^2 - (\sigma_L^2)_i}{2(\sigma_T^2 + (\sigma_L^2)_i))^2}}{\sum_{i=1}^n \frac{1}{2(\sigma_T^2 + (\sigma_L^2)_i))^2}}$$



NFL Quarterback Interception Percentage




Touchdown Passes

passes resulting in touchdowns



NFL Quarterback Touchdown Passes




PERCENTAGE SACKED

PERCENTAGE SACKED




Player	Observed	True Talent	League Average	Standard Deviation

Implications and Suggestions for Future Research

Alternative methods that eliminate the bias of the quarterback position:

- Perform regression to the mean within other positions and players on the field
- Change up the dataset! Look at game totals rather than season totals.
- Consider a Bradley Terry Model to account for Home Field Advantage.
- Consider a Rasch model to compare Brady's talent to that of his receivers, or the defense of the opposing team.
