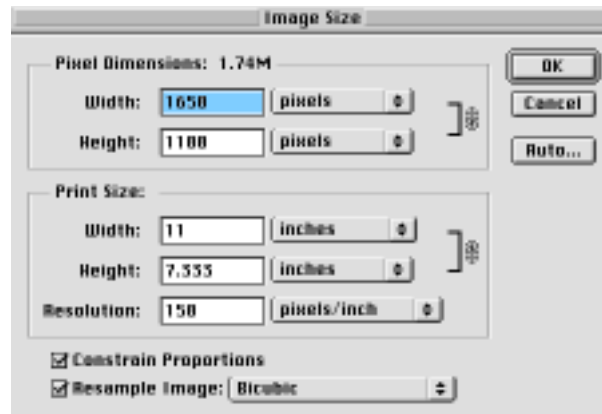


Adobe Photoshop - Slide Instructions

Photoshop by Adobe is a photo editing program. It is used to manipulate scanned images for output to prints, overheads and slides. For the best possible results please follow the guidelines below.

• Image Size and File Size:

- Go to **Image Size** in the **Image** menu: adjust the *Print Size* dimensions and resolution so that the overall file size is approximately 1mb, if *Grayscale*, and 3mb if *RGB*. (If you use a page size of 7.33 inches x 11 inches, which will exactly fill the 35mm slide, set the resolution 120 - 150 dpi.)
- Remember, a slide should be a 2 x 3 aspect ratio so that the image fills the slide frame area. The slide mount will cover approximately 5%-7% of the image all the way around.



• Mode:

Grayscale or **RGB** (CMYK images may not print correct colors)

• Save As:

TIFF (.tif)

- No Layers**
- No Compression**
- No Clipping Paths**
- No Alpha Channels**
