APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS	HONORS IN CULTURAL & SOCIAL ANTHROPOLOGY
Apply	During the Senior year and by the end of the 2 nd week of winter quarter (Friday, 18 January 2002).
Select	A research topic
Enlist	A CASA faculty Honors Advisor (usually your program advisor)
Obtain	Honors Advisor to approve the application for review by UG Committee
Register	CASA 95A. or CASA 96. or CASA 99A, B, or C. during winter quarter Senior year and at the time of your Honors application to the Department
Submit	Turn in the CASA Honors Application* by Friday, 19 January 2001 An official transcript with a 3.5 GPA in the Major and a 3.0 GPA overall, minimum. No more than one "Incomplete" listed on the transcript at the time of application. An abstract of proposed Honors thesis A draft of the Senior paper A bibliography A letter of recommendation (sealed) by the Honors Advisor
