MONTANA'S SECOND SET OF INTERROGATORIES AND REQUESTS FOR PRODUCTION TO WYOMING

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Pursuant to Case Management Plan No. 1 (December 20, 2011) ("CMP No. 1"), as modified, Plaintiff the State of Montana hereby propounds its Second Set of Interrogatories and Requests for Production to the State of Wyoming. The State of Wyoming is requested to respond in accordance with Section VIII.C.1 of CMP No. 1.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. In responding to these interrogatories and requests for production, you are required to furnish all information and documents that are available to you or subject to your reasonable inquiry including information in the possession of your attorneys, representatives, and anyone else otherwise subject to your control.
- 2. In responding to these interrogatories and requests for production, you must make a diligent search of your records and of other papers and materials in your possession or available to you or your representatives, including electronically stored information.
- 3. If an interrogatory or request for production has subparts, answer each part separately and in full, and do not limit your answer to the interrogatory or request for production as a whole. If these interrogatories or requests for production cannot be answered in full, answer to the extent possible, specify the reason for your inability to answer the remainder, and state whatever information and knowledge you have regarding the unanswered portion.

- 4. With respect to each interrogatory or request for production, in addition to supplying the information asked for and identifying the specific documents referred to, identify and describe all documents to which you refer in preparing your answers.
- 5. The interrogatories and requests for production are continuing and the answers thereto must be supplemented as provided in Section VIII.H of CMP No. 1.
- 6. For information you withhold because of a claim of privilege, state the general nature of the information and set forth the nature of the privileged claim, as to each document over which privilege is claimed, state the date of the document, the author of the document, the person to whom the document is addressed, the general substance of the document and the reason the privilege is claimed.
- 7. If your answer to any interrogatory or request for admission is that you lack knowledge of the requested information, describe all efforts made by you to obtain the information necessary to answer that interrogatory, request for production or request for admission.
- 8. If any interrogatory, request for production or request for admission cannot be satisfied in full, satisfy it to the fullest extent possible, specifying the reasons for your inability to respond fully, and identify the date by which you will make a complete response.

DEFINITIONS

Unless otherwise indicated, the following definitions shall be applicable to the interrogatory, request for production, and request for admission:

A. "CBM" means coalbed methane production or development.

- B. "CBM water" means water produced in connection with coalbed methane production or development.
- C. The term "communication" means any formal or informal, written or oral, recorded or unrecorded, exchange of ideas or information.
 - D. "Compact" means the Yellowstone River Compact.
- E. The words "document" and "documents" mean all written, recorded, electronic or graphic matters, however produced or reproduced, whether or not privileged, pertaining in any way to the subject matter of this action. This definition includes, but is not limited to, any and all originals, copies, or drafts of any and all of the following: records; notes; summaries; schedules; contracts or agreements; drawings; sketches; invoices, orders or acknowledgements; diaries, reports, forecasts or appraisals; memoranda of telephone or in person conversations by or with any person, or any other memoranda; letters, emails, telegrams, telexes, or cables prepared, drafted, received or sent; tapes, transcripts, or recordings; photographs, pictures or films; computer programs or data or other graphic, symbolic, recorded or written materials of any nature whatsoever. Any document which contains any comment, notation, addition, insertion or marking of any kind which is not part of another document or any document which does not contain any comment, notation, addition, insertion, or marking of any kind which is part of another document, is to be considered a separate document.

In each instance wherein you are asked to identify or describe a document, or provide identification of a document, your description should be sufficient to satisfy the requirements of CMP No. 1 and should include, but not be limited to:

- (1) The nature of the document or writing, e.g., letter, memorandum, etc.;
- (2) the name, address, telephone number, occupation, job title and employer of the present custodian of the document;
- (3) by whom the document or writing was prepared, including that person's name, address, telephone number, occupation, job title and employer;
- (4) the date of the making of the document and the name, address, telephone number, occupation, job title and employer of each person whose testimony could be used to authenticate such document and lay the foundation for its introduction into evidence;
- (5) to whom the document was sent, including those persons' names, addresses, telephone numbers, occupations, job titles and employers.
- F. The term "identify" in reference to an event or occurrence shall mean to state the date, time and place of the event or occurrence, the persons present or participating, the topic of discussion, and any documents presented by or exchanged among one or more of the participants.
- G. "Knowledge" includes first-hand information and information derived from any other source including hearsay knowledge.
 - H. "Parcel" shall mean a distinct, continuous portion or tract of land.

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- I. "Person" shall mean and include a natural person, kind of business or legal entity, its agents, directors, officer or employees.
- J. "Powder River" shall include all tributaries to the Powder River, including the Little Powder River.

- K. The terms "regulate" and "regulation" shall mean any act intentionally undertaken by an official, employee, or agent of a state, to limit, curtail, control, adjust, or regulate the quantity of water available to one or more Water Right or holders of Water Rights or available to any other water users who lack Water Rights, including, but not limited to, physical acts, orders, administrative proceedings, or litigation initiated by the official, employee or agent.
 - L. "Tongue River" shall include all tributaries to the Tongue River.
- M. "water right" shall mean a water right of any kind or nature, including, but not limited to, adjudicated, non-adjudicated, federal reserved, surface, storage, and instream or groundwater rights, within the State of Wyoming.
- N. The term "water user" shall mean any individual, entity or corporation, including public and private institutions, that has a water right, or diverts or appropriates water.
- O. The terms "you" or "your" shall refer to the State of Wyoming, including any of its employees or agents.

Please identify each person answering or supplying information for the answering of these interrogatories, identifying the number of the interrogatory that the person answered or supplied information for answering.

In the Yellowstone River Compact Commission Fifty-Second Annual Report 2003, http://yrcc.usgs.gov/support.docs/YRCCAnnualReport2003.pdf, Pat Tyrrell stated that "Wyoming has also expended considerable effort to reduce consumption of water and help alleviate shortages, particularly for municipalities through issue of temporary permits and temporary sharing of water rights." With regard to this statement please:

- (a) Identify each municipality to which Mr. Tyrrell refers.
- (b) Explain what a "temporary permit" is.
- (c) Identify each "temporary permit" by number, entity name, flow rate, volume, purpose, priority date, and length of time permit is effective.
- (d) Explain what Mr. Tyrrell meant by "temporary sharing of water rights."

(e) Identify each water right involved in the "temporary sharing of water rights" by number, entity name, flow rate, volume, purpose, priority date, and the period of time in which it was involved in the temporary sharing.

Sue Lowry of the State Engineer's Office explained the water right attribution process begins with mapping irrigated lands parcels from aerial photography on a quad-level scale. The consulting team will then research the records in the State Engineer's Office to identify groupings of water rights associated with the irrigated parcels. This process does not map water rights. It is known there are a lot more paper rights on the books than there is water actually being used. Knowing the number of acres irrigated, the type of crops irrigated, and the consumptive requirement of the crops, the actual water use can be determined as opposed to a determination of the total water rights that are on the books.

With regard to this statement please:
