During the Telephonic Status Conference held on Monday, January 14, 2013, the States agreed to confer on the issue of an extension of the dates set forth in Case Management Plan No. 1 ("CMP NO. 1"), as modified by Case Management Order No. 10 ("CMO No. 10"). The States are pleased to inform you that they have agreed to the following proposed dates:

Wyoming's Expert Designation: April 2

Montana's Rebuttal Expert Designation: June 4

Last Day for Propounding Written Discovery: June 11

As you can see, in addition to the dates set forth in CMP No. 1, the States are also proposing a date for the disclosure of non-expert witnesses, and are specifying that the July 3rd deadline would be for dispositive motions. The States do not believe that they will be in a position to determine other potential evidentiary motions *in limine* by that date. The proposed dates should allow sufficient time for a trial to begin on October 1, 2013.
