WYOMING'S STATUS REPORT NO. 15

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The State of Wyoming presents the following Status Report No. 15 pursuant to Section VII.D. of Case Management Plan No.1:

1. Wyoming deposed the following individuals and entities during the month of March 2013: Bret Aye, Greg Losinski, Jay Nance, Raymond Harwood, Ray Muggli, Miles City Town & Country, David Borntreger, Gary Ochsner, Russell Jorgensen, Hardesty Tract Homeowners Association, Bert Meged, Kyle Shaw, Robert Thaden, Dick Brewer, Gerhard Helm, Duane Mathison, Felton Angus Ranch, Great Northern Properties, Adams Ranch, City of Miles City, Alfred Leatherberry, John Hamilton, Richard Anderson, Diamond Cross Ranch, Fred Mueller, William Carrel, Paradox Land Company, Tim Lohof, Bigsky Coal, and Bruce Haley.

2. On March 14, 2013, Montana served its Responses to Wyoming's Third Interrogatories, and on March 29, 2013, Montana served its Responses to Wyoming's Second Request for Production of Documents. Wyoming is generally dissatisfied with the responses to these discovery requests and will set forth its concerns with these responses in a letter to Montana in the near future.

3. On March 29, 2013, the Court held a status conference in this matter. Neither Wyoming nor Montana raised any substantive or procedural issues during the conference.

4. On April 2, 2013, Wyoming filed its Expert Designation and placed the expert reports of Mr. Hinckley, Mr. Fritz, and Dr. Schreüder on the following publically accessible website: <http://www.primath.com/yellowstone/>. The parties have discussed dates for the depositions of these witnesses and hope to have the schedule finalized within the next week.

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
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
