

14. FBI, POLICE OR OTHER ENFORCING AGENCY INTERVIEW REQUEST. An FBI agent has contacted me requesting an interview. What should I do?

First, find out the subject matter of the proposed interview. If the subject matter concerns the business of the University or the Hospitals, immediately contact the Office of the General Counsel at 723-9611.

If the subject matter is personal you may proceed with the interview at your own discretion. There is no University policy that prohibits investigating officers from coming onto campus and interviewing individuals. Before scheduling a voluntary interview, you may choose to consult with an attorney. Students may contact the Legal Counseling Office of the ASSU, <http://assu.stanford.edu/lco/>. Faculty and staff may locate an attorney through a lawyer referral service in the area.
