### Internet Access (register online)

- All residential rooms have high-speed data ports (100Mbps). The cost for summer Internet service is \$75 for the entire summer, or \$30 per week for each computer.

- Calling card, major credit card, or calling collect is required for placing International long distance calls.
- Only one line and phone number available per room.
- Voicemail not available; guests have option of supplying their own phone answering machines.
