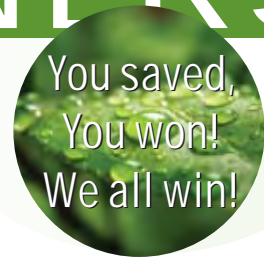


THE WINNERS
