-- In order to gain the lower level of priority at Chi Theta Chi for the 2008-2009 draw, prospective residents must submit a copy of this form signed by a current staff member confirming that they have taken a house tour at Chi Theta Chi and completed a house job or other project at any co-op on campus.

-- The higher level of priority involves completing the following:

- a) Completing the criteria for the lower level of priority (XOX tour and job at any co-op).
- b) Listing Chi Theta Chi as your first choice in your housing preferences.
- c) Attending the Chi Theta Chi Priority Workday at the end of the priority period (Saturday, April 26th) Note: – you should be informed about this Priority Workday on you house tour. Please contact Erik Nygren (nygren@stanford.edu) with any questions about this.
