

**EBF Priority Application  
2008 – 2009**

The Enchanted Broccoli Forrest (commonly referred to as “EBF”) is a co-op located on the lake, near Namia and KA. In order to gain priority at EBF for the draw next year, prospective residents must submit a copy of this form signed by a current staff member confirming that they have completed the requirements described below:

Priority 1: is given if the prospective student that has chosen EBF as their first choice on their housing preference list, and has performed either of the following options:

- a) **3** jobs at EBF (Sunday-Thursday: cook 3-6pm or clean 7-9pm)
- b) **2** jobs at EBF (Sunday-Thursday: cook 3-6pm or clean 7-9pm) plus a **creative expression** of why that resident wants to be in the house (can be an essay or any other form).

Priority 2: is given if the prospective student has performed **1 job** at EBF (Sunday-Thursday: cook 3-6pm or clean 7-9pm).

Priority 3: is given if the prospective resident has visited EBF and performed a job at any other co-op.
