

Synergy Co-Op, 2008 - 2009

Synergy is an intentional community founded upon the tenet of "exploring alternative lifestyles." This has been expressed in a number of ways in the past. Today, Synergy is an all-vegetarian co-op, where members of the community do weekly kitchen jobs and quarterly house jobs, and all decisions are made by group consensus. Since the community of Synergy is dependent on the commitment of its residents, the following priority steps must be taken. To gain priority at Synergy, fulfill all of these steps and have them signed off by a current staff member confirming that they have been completed:

Priority Level 1:

1. Take a house tour (about 20-30 minutes) describing the inner workings of the house.
2. Complete a job (could be anything from cleaning to cooking to working in a garden) at any of the co-ops. If job is completed at another co-op, a signed form must be shown at Synergy.
