Licensing Information:

Family Child Care Homes are required by law to maintain a current operating license by the California Department of Social Services/Community Care Licensing division. Large family child care homes may be licensed for either 12 or 14 children. If licensed for 12, no more than 4 may be infants (0-2yrs.). If licensed for 14, 2 children must be at least 6 years of age and no more than 3 may be infants.

Licensed Small Family Child Care Homes in Palo Alto

Licensing Information:

Family Child Care Homes are required by law to maintain a current operating license by the California Department of Social Services/Community Care Licensing division. Small family child care homes may be licensed for either 6 or 8 children. If licensed for 6, no more than 3 may be infants (0-2yrs.) or 4 if all children are infants. If licensed for 8, 2 children must be at least 6 years of age and no more than 2 may be infants.
