



## Lactation Spaces

Stanford employees should contact their supervisor/manager or Human Resources (HR) Manager to work out a solution to meet their lactation space needs. Examples of arrangements include scheduling conference rooms, using an absent person's office (with permission), or hanging temporary blinds/curtains to create a private space. Department, building, facility or space coordinators may have information about possible use of space and whom to contact for permission. The rooms listed below are, for the most part, multi-purpose spaces that may be available to be used for lactation purposes.
