2008 to 2010 HATE CRIMES

Hate crimes are crimes in which the victim is intentionally selected because of the actual or perceived race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, or disability of the victim.

- 2010** One incident of hate related threats on campus characterized by racial bias
One incident of hate related vandalism in a student residence characterized by racial bias
- 2009** One report of hate related vandalism on campus characterized by religious bias
One report of hate related battery on campus characterized by sexual orientation bias
- 2008** One report of hate related vandalism on campus characterized by religious bias
