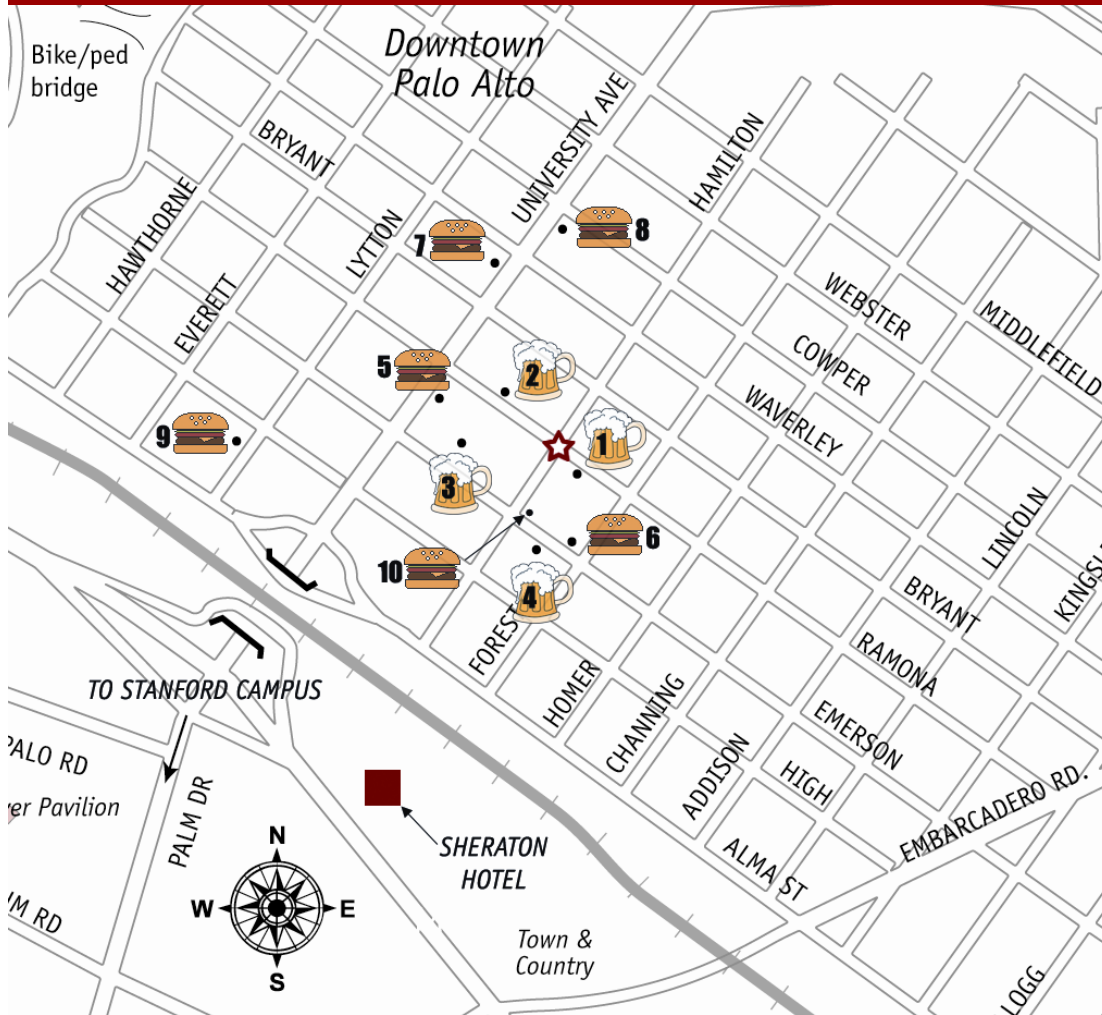

DRINK SPECIALS FOR ASB PARTICIPANTS

A few bars are offering drink specials for the "ASB Night On The Town" so be sure to **bring your ASB badges with you!**
See the bar descriptions on the back for the specials at each bar.

BARS

1. **Blue Chalk Café:** This is a happening bar that is great for playing pool or just chilling out in the comfy lounge. *Specials: \$3 draft beer, \$4 well drinks*
2. **Nola:** Nola has a funky setting that makes you want to linger for hours in one of their two lounges or on the open air patio. The huge bar supplies dangerous, not-to-miss Hurricanes. *Specials: \$5 Hurricanes, \$2 pints*

The Old Pro: Located right next to Nola, this is a sports bar with good beer, decent food, and lots of seating. Many food items on the menu are served until 1AM.

3. **Rose & Crown:** This small, cozy English-style pub has a great selection of beers on tap (best in Palo Alto) and obscure British and Belgian ales. And you won't feel out of place... it has a college-town bar feel.
4. **Gordon Biersch:** Gordon Biersch is a brewery local to the Bay, and this location in PA was the first! You can sit under the huge silver beer tanks that tell you the beer is produced on-site and sample one of their classic, German inspired microbrews or seasonal specialty beers. The kitchen makes good grub, most of which has beer as an ingredient.

RESTAURANTS

5. **Pizza My Heart:** A Bay Area pizzeria, this is a great place to grab a quick slice or sit down and order an entire pie. *Open until 12AM.*
6. **Buca di Beppo:** Everything is served family style at this Italian restaurant. Come with an appetite because the portions are huge. There's usually a wait, so plan on having a drink at the bar. Beppo's is the perfect place for a big group. *Open until 10PM.*
7. **The Cheesecake Factory:** This nation-wide chain is defined by a huge menu of upscale casual fare that's a bit pricey. It's certainly not unique, but the place has a diverse menu that fits most palates and a large seating capacity that makes it good for large parties. *Open until 11PM.*
8. **Pluto's:** This Northern California chain has fresh, healthy food fast. Get a hand-tossed salad with fixings like jicama, walnuts, and grilled fennel, or some home-style roasted turkey, stuffing, and mashed potatoes with gravy. With a variety of sides, sandwiches, and entrees, there's something for every appetite. *Open until 10PM.*
9. **Darbar Indian Cuisine:** Darbar offers great food, warm service, and reasonable prices. Be sure to try the naan, spicy lamb, tandoori chicken, and spiced tea. *Open until 10PM.*
10. **The Peninsula Creamery:** Stop in for one of the best milkshakes you've ever had. This place has that old diner feel, with food to match. They serve breakfast all day, along with lunch and dinner plates. There is also an in-house bakery that makes decadent treats like Key Lime Pie and Breakfast Buns. *Open until 11PM.*
