

1 Plaintiff submitted an itemized list of attorneys' fees, prepared by Plaintiff
2 personally. The amount of time spent litigating Plaintiff's claim was nominal. The finding
3 is \$225.00 to \$275.00 per hour is a reasonable hourly rate for an attorney. Accordingly,
4 Plaintiff is awarded \$62,101.99 in attorney's fees pursuant to Labor Code § 2802.

5 Because the issue of damages, \$75,000.00, is on appeal, *Jacobson v Clack, PNA, C. A.*
6 No. 2017(2021), this decision does not address the issue of damages paid to Clack and no
7 decision will be issued that is currently being considered in the Superior Court for the
8 District of Columbia.

9 Labor Code Sections 98.1(c) and 2802 provide that all awards granted pursuant to
10 this hearing shall accrue interest on all due and unpaid wages, including liquidated
11 damages and business expenses, from the date that said wages became due until the wages
12 are paid. Therefore, Plaintiff is entitled to \$7,452.24 in interest accrued to date.


13 CONCLUSION

14 For all the foregoing reasons, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant pays
15 Plaintiff as follows:

- 16 1. \$62,101.99 for reimbursable business expenses pursuant to Labor Code Section
17 2802(c); and
- 18 2. \$7,452.24 in interest pursuant to Labor Code Sections 98.1, and 2802.

19 The total award to Plaintiff is \$69,554.23.
