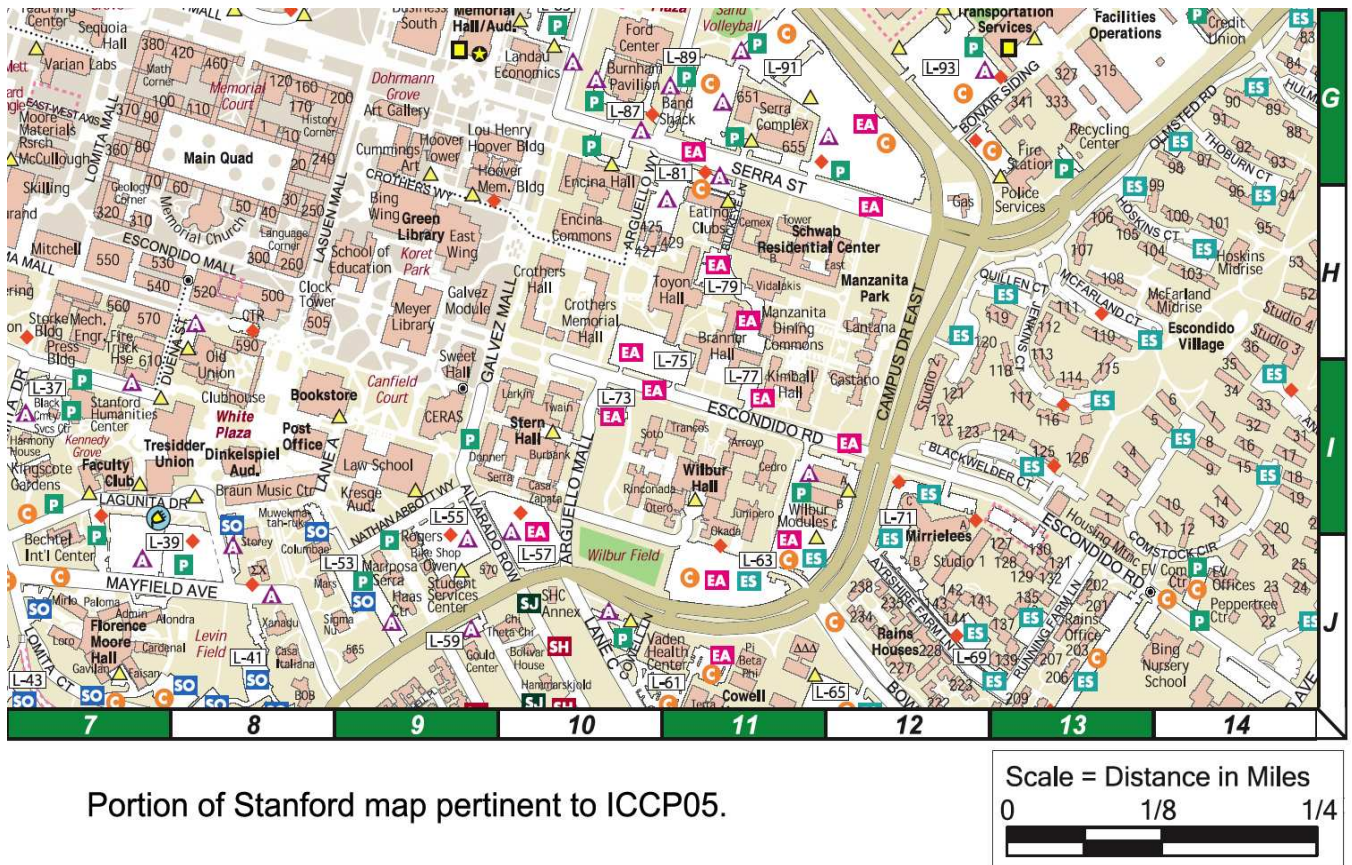


What, Where, and When

Audio-Visual Apparatus
