Our conference speaker, Ken Myers, is the executive producer at Mars Hill Audio, a nonprofit organization devoted to helping Christians think wisely about modern culture through a variety of audio resources. For eight years he was a producer and editor for National Public Radio, working for much of that time as arts and humanities editor for the two news programs, *Morning Edition* and *All Things Considered*. Mr. Myers is a graduate of the University of Maryland, where he studied film theory and criticism, and of Westminster Theological Seminary in Philadelphia.
