






Huntingtin (Htt): expanded polyglutamine (polyQ) tract causes Huntington's disease (HD)

Visualization of Htt-ex1 aggregates at the nanoscale by single-molecule fluorescence super-resolution imaging in a PC12m cell model














Fibrillar aggregates in axonal process
