



RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION SIDEWALK AND PEDESTRIAN PATH REPAIR AND REHABILITATION

Sidewalks and pedestrian paths in the Residential Subdivision have been inspected and the areas needing repairs have been identified. A project to repair and rehabilitate the sidewalks and pedestrian paths is being undertaken by SCRL and Stanford Facilities Operations.

Pedestrian Paths

Pedestrian paths are the asphalt walkways in the common areas or which lead to greenbelt areas or are between houses linking streets in the Residential Subdivision. The paths have been inspected and prioritized by condition and usage into 5 phases. Funding has been approved to repair and rehabilitate the paths in Phases 1 and 2 at this time. A map with the Phase 1 and 2 paths to be repaired and rehabilitated during this project is available on the SCRL website (www.scrl.org).

The project is scheduled to commence in September 2004 and be completed in November 2004. Work hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Sidewalks

Sidewalks are the concrete or asphalt walkways along the street frontage (front and side yards) of the homes in the Residential Subdivision. The sidewalks have been inspected and the locations needing repair identified. The Provost has approved funding for the first phase of sidewalk repairs. A list of property addresses where sidewalk repairs will be made during the first phase is available on the SCRL website (www.scrl.org).

Repair work is scheduled to begin in September 2004 and continue through April 2005. Work hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Saturday.
