Stanford SWE Scholarship Program

The SWE Scholarship Program at Stanford awards five active members who have demonstrated leadership, social responsibility, and a commitment to women's issues in engineering. Scholarships are announced at the SWE End of the Year Banquet in May.

Stanford SWE has various opportunities for student involvement, from outreach programs to engineering competitions to career networking events. The goal of the SWE Scholarship Program is to award students who have stretched beyond the requirements of membership and made their own contributions to the SWE community, and the greater community at Stanford. It is this initiative that fosters leadership and positive change in the larger scope of academia and industry.

All nationally registered SWE members at Stanford, excluding the current executive board, are eligible to apply. The selection committee will consist of the executive board (President, Vice President Internal, Vice President External, Vice President of Membership) and volunteer representatives from sponsoring companies. Applicants will submit a completed application consisting of short-answer questions and a copy of their most recent resume. Decisions will be made based on the frequency and quality of participation in SWE activities, as well as academic performance, community involvement, activities, and the quality of the application.

As a corporate sponsor, you will directly help these deserving students, and your company's name and logo will be included in the scholarship and on the Stanford SWE website. You will also receive a resume compilation CD of all the applicants. Corporate sponsorship involves donating at one of the following levels (Silver, Gold, Platinum) and providing a point of contact for the selection committee. At the end of the year the committee will evaluate the applications and select five winners from the candidate pool.
