Your Stanford ID Card...more than a photo ID

- *Cash up your card and use it to buy food, books, and many other articles around campus; and as a debit card for vending and copy machines.*
- *Present your card when checking out library books.*
- *Use your card to gain access to athletic facilities and workout areas.*

WHAT IS THE CAMPUS CARD? The Stanford ID Card is more than a simple photo ID — it also provides electronic access to a variety of facilities and services around campus. The StanfordCardPlan, a prepaid expense plan associated with every card, lets you use your Stanford Card to purchase goods and services such as meals, sundries, and copying. You can add funds to your card at Cash-to-Card machines conveniently located around campus, or at the Cashier's Office in Tresidder Union, 459 Lagunita Drive, 2nd Floor.

The StanfordCardPlan and most of the applications and services described below are also available to Courtesy Card holders. See the Campus Card web site for a list of those who qualify for a Courtesy Card.

WHY SHOULD I USE IT?

- *Access control*—many departments and facilities on campus use card readers on doors, turnstiles, and elevators to control access to buildings and rooms. Access can be restricted by day of the week and time of day, and can be set up to give access on an individual basis, or by department or class list.
- *Campus cafes*—if you participate in the StanfordCardPlan, you can use your Stanford ID Card in place of cash to purchase food at all residential dining locations, plus a number of other locations around campus, including:
 - Tresidder Union CoHo & Subway
 - Peet's Coffee
 - Moon Bean's Cafe
 - Sports Cafe
 - Jamba Juice
 - Alumni Cafe
 - Olive's Cafe at Building 160
- *Campus retail*—use your Stanford ID Card instead of a charge card at the following retail locations: the University Bookstore—textbooks, general books, computers and peripherals, clothing, cards and stationery, notebooks, CDs, etc.; Tresidder Express Convenience Store—toiletries, laundry supplies, snacks, etc.; Tresidder and Meyer Technology desks—a limited selection of computer and office supplies.
- *Privileges/entitlement*—the Stanford ID Card doubles as your library card. You must present your Stanford ID Card when checking out books. Vaden Health Center uses the Stanford Card to verify health plan service levels. StanfordCardPlan participants can also use the card to pay for prescriptions at the Health Center.
- *Athletic facilities and workout areas*—your Stanford ID Card entitles you to use Stanford's workout areas around campus, as well as its gyms, pools, and other athletic facilities.
- *Debit card*—Use your Stanford ID Card as a debit card for vending and copy machines.

WHAT DOES IT COST? Initial cards are issued at no charge to regular faculty, staff, and students.

- Lost cards incur a \$20.00 replacement fee.
- Stolen cards are replaced at no charge if a copy of a police report is submitted.
- Courtesy Cards are available for \$20.00.
