Your Stanford ID Card is your entry key.

WHAT IS ONLINE ACCESS CONTROL? Online Access Control uses the central Stanford ID Card system in place of keys to open doors. Many departments and facilities on campus use card readers on doors, turnstiles, and elevators to control and monitor access to buildings and rooms. Access can be restricted by day of the week and time of day. Groups can be set up to give access to an individual or to a department.

WHY SHOULD I USE IT? Online Access Control improves building security, provides a cost-effective solution for door access using the Stanford ID Card, and can reduce the cost of re-keying locks and replacing lost keys. Specific benefits include:

- *A keying system that's already in place*—Grant access using a key that members of the Stanford community already have—the Stanford ID Card.
- *Convenience and efficiency*—Manage access with a departmental workstation and portable device, using automated system feeds. That means you can change the door access programming, or have doors open and lock on an automated schedule.
- *Centrally managed security*—Limit and define access to those who are authorized and eligible to use facilities for the time period they are eligible to use them.
- *Usage tracking*—Generate reports detailing, for example, who can get in, when they can get in, and who did get in.
- *Permissions flexibility*—Activate access privileges for those people who are authorized, deactivate access privileges of those who are no longer authorized (no more key collection or re-keying), and give global access to groups of people such as emergency responders or maintenance workers.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

Project management fee	\$850
Covers management and coordinating of access installations and operations. Includes the private fiber backbone, infrastructure devices, and software database.	
Workstation installation (per unit)	\$150
Workstation per unit monthly fee*	\$50
Includes software upgrades, support, and interface connectivity.	
Access point per unit monthly fee	\$9–25
Access point modification	To be determined
Depending on electrical needs and conduit path, additional costs will apply to modify the door, gate, or turnstile that serves as the access point.	

*If you already run Offline Access Control on a workstation, you can bundle Online Access Control for a total per unit monthly fee of \$75.
