The Santa Clara Valley Chapter of the California Native Plant Society is offering scholarships to graduate students doing research on plant systematics, plant ecology, plant physiology, plant community restoration or other related botanical studies of plants that grow in habitats in Central and Northern California. Students researching topics related to rare plants are encouraged to apply.

Three \$1,500 scholarships are available. Evaluation of student applications will focus on the stated purpose of the research, experimental design, and overall impression of the research project.

Scholarship Requirements

Applicants should be enrolled in a graduate program in an accredited College or University and undertaking botanical research related to plants or native plant communities in Central or Northern California.
