Use [Databases](#) [24] to find full-text newspaper articles. Try one of these:

- [America's Newspapers](#) [67]: content of local and regional news, including community events, schools, politics, government policies, cultural activities, local companies, state industries, and people in the community.
- [LexisNexis](#) [68]: major U.S. and world news sources, TV and Radio transcripts, as well as selected Blog content.
- [Global Newsbank](#) [69]: material from hundreds of news sources from around the world including wire services, broadcasts, transcripts, newspapers and periodicals.
- [AltPress Watch](#) [70]: database of newspapers, magazines and journals from alternative and independent presses.
- [Ethnic Newswatch](#) [71]: an interdisciplinary, bilingual (English and Spanish) and comprehensive database of newspapers, magazines and journals from ethnic, minority and native presses.
